

William Wallace - "Braveheart"

**We
Recommend:**

Kryolan
Aquacolor
Royal Blue #510
or Global Body
Art in Blue
or Kryolan Grease
Stick in Blue

A brush or small
sponge with one
flat sharp edge.



TECHNIQUE:

- Using the brush or the sharp edge of the sponge (or grease stick), draw a line down the centre of the face and blend colour from the nose to the hairline on one side.
- Half of the other side of the face should be make-up free.
- On the opposite side, draw a line from the hairline above the temple to the corner of the eye.
- Draw the line around the cheekbone and then take it diagonally across the jaw line towards the corner of the mouth.
- Fill with colour to the neck and ears.
- Don't worry too much about getting an even coverage of colour – Braveheart didn't!

TIPS & TRICKS: Water based make-up is recommended for low impact activities and short term wear. Aquacolor dries to a powder finish, buff away excess powder with a dry make-up brush or soft towel. When dry, Global has a soft matt finish and does not transfer colour or powder to clothes. Washes off with soap and water. For high impact activities such as stage performance, (or simply partying all night) grease-based make-up will last longer and give denser coverage. Set with powder and buff the excess with a dry make-up brush or towel. However, please consider that grease make-up can stain fabrics and should be removed with make-up remover.
