

FALSE EYELASHES are an easy way to achieve a really dramatic effect!



1. We recommend applying lashes after your foundation and before eye colour. Draw a steady line right above your lashline with black or brown eyeliner, smudge for a smoky effect. This will help disguise the lash band.

2. Check the width of the lashes and if necessary trim from the outer edge (where the lashes are longest) to match the width of your eye.

TIP: Don't apply lashes too close to the inner corner of your eye or they will be uncomfortable and may work loose.

3. Cut the lashes in half and only use the outer edges if you don't need full coverage. Flex the lashes so they will conform to your eye before applying the glue.

4. Apply a very thin line of glue along the false lash with a toothpick - a minimal amount is needed, add more if required.

5. Wait a few seconds for the glue to go tacky. Beginning at the outer edge, apply the false lash above your own eyelashes, as close to the lash line as possible and following the natural curve of your eye.

6. Adjust the position with your fingers, tweezers or a toothpick before the adhesive sets. Hold firmly in place until set.

7. Apply eyeshadow when the glue is dry, use a clean brush to remove excess powder. A light coat of mascara will help the false lashes blend with your own (not recommended for metallic lashes.)

TIP: Practice a few times before the night. Lashes can be re-used and adhesive is available to buy separately.

9. To remove, wash your face in warm water and use a gentle eye make-up remover to loosen the adhesive. Clean lashes in soapy water and remove excess glue before storing in original packaging for re-use.

10. **NOTE:** Eyelash adhesive is made from latex. DO NOT use if you are allergic to latex products.
