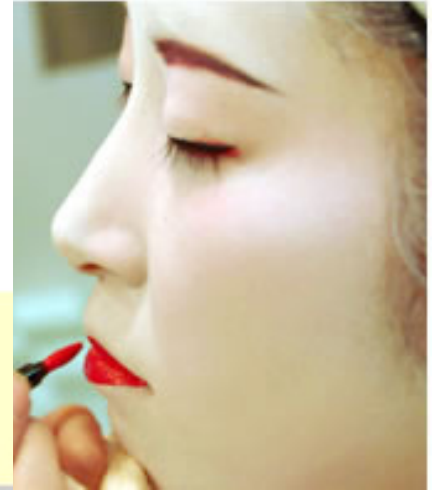


## The Secret Life of a GEISHA:

### We recommend:

- Aquacolor White #70
- Black eyeliner pencil or liquid eyeliner
- Bright Red eyeshadow or Red Aquacolor
- Bright red lipstick in matt (not gloss)
- Rose coloured Blush
- Fine make-up brush
- Mascara if necessary.



### Technique:

- Cover the entire face and neck to the hairline with white base using a damp sponge. Kryolan Aquacolor is highly recommended as it provides a soft powder finish which is very close to traditional Geisha make-up.
- The cheek and eye area can be covered with a slight blush of pink. Colour should be subtle.
- Outline the eyes with red eyeshadow, along the upper and lower lash lines.
- Line the upper lid with black very close the lashline.
- Eyebrows should be defined by first applying a small amount of red colour, then sculpted with black pencil.
- Lips should be carefully painted in a 'cupids bow' shape, just inside the line of the lips.
- Japanese women usually have naturally black eyelashes, use mascara if necessary.



**TIPS & TRICKS:** Water based make-up is recommended for low impact activities and short term wear. Aquacolor dries to a powder finish, buff away excess powder with a dry make-up brush or soft towel. When dry, Global has a soft matt finish and does not transfer colour or powder to clothes. Washes off with soap and water. For high impact activities such as stage performance, (or simply partying all night) grease-based make-up will last longer and give denser coverage. Set with powder and buff the excess with a dry make-up brush or towel. However, please consider that grease make-up can stain fabrics and should be removed with make-up remover.
