

It's easy being GREEN.



We recommend:

**Aquacolor Green or Global "Shrek Green" Makeup or Craft Paintbrush
Latex or Sea Sponge.
Brown or Black Eye pencil
Options: Shrek Ears & Spirit Gum, Bald Cap.**



- With a face which is clean and dry, work from the nose out towards the hairline.
- If using Aquacolor, two coats may be necessary. Wait for the first coat to dry completely before adding the next. Remember to blend into the eye sockets (but take care around the eyes), the corners of the mouth and the ears.
- If using Global, blend the colour quickly when wet for even coverage. A brush is recommended for a smooth application, a sponge will give a more transparent (natural) effect.
- For The Mask, do not blend colour below the jawline – it's a mask!
- Eyebrows can be defined using black or brown pencil. Lips should be pale and natural (not too green!)
- For Shrek and The Mask, a bald cap may be used. Trim the cap to size for a custom fit. However, Aquacolor and Supracolor are not formulated to work on a bald cap - we recommend using Global or Acrylic craft paint.
- Shrek Ears can be applied to the sides of the forehead using Spirit Gum. Apply a small amount to the edge of the ears and wait 30 seconds to go tacky before pressing into place. Remove with care, we recommend Spirit Gum Remover or baby oil.



TIPS & TRICKS: Water based make-up is recommended for low impact activities and short term wear. Aquacolor dries to a powder finish, buff away excess powder with a dry make-up brush or soft towel. When dry, Global has a soft matt finish and does not transfer colour or powder to clothes. Washes off with soap and water. For high impact activities such as stage performance, (or simply partying all night) grease-based make-up will last longer and give denser coverage. Set with powder and buff the excess with a dry make-up brush or towel. However, please consider that grease make-up can stain fabrics and should be removed with make-up remover.
