

KISS and Make Up

We recommend:

Aquacolor or Grease stick in
White #70

Aquacolor or Grease stick in
Black #71

Aquacolor or Grease stick in
Green #36

Interferenze or Grease stick in
Silver Grey

Red lipstick

Paintbrush

Soft Black eyeliner pencil.



- Start by drawing the lines of the design with the eyeliner pencil, using the features of your face as guidelines for placement. Draw the points of the patterns in the corresponding position on your face, then join up with connecting lines.
- Use these photos to guide you. See how the pattern covers the eye socket and extending lines match up with the positions of the eyebrows, ears, nose and mouth.
- **Colours should not be overlaid.** Start with the white, leaving areas where other colours will be applied blank. Black which is applied over white will appear grey. If using Aquacolor or Global, wait for it to dry before proceeding with the next colour. This will prevent the paint from blending at the edges.
- A small paintbrush will keep colour within the lines.
- Always finish with the black. Colour should be dense. Use a second coat once the first has dried if necessary.



TIPS & TRICKS: Water based make-up is recommended for low impact activities and short term wear. Aquacolor dries to a powder finish, buff away excess powder with a dry make-up brush or soft towel. When dry, Global has a soft matt finish and does not transfer colour or powder to clothes. Washes off with soap and water. For high impact activities such as stage performance, (or simply partying all night) grease-based make-up will last longer and give denser coverage. Set with powder and buff the excess with a dry make-up brush or towel. However, please consider that grease make-up can stain fabrics and should be removed with make-up remover.
